\* This Code provides an international standards for the safe carriage by ships of dangerous and noxious chemicals in bulk. To minimize risks to the ships involved in such carriage, to their crews and to the environment, the Code prescribes the design and construction standards of ships and the equipment they should carry, with due regard to the nature of the products involved. In December 1985, by a resolution (MEPC.19(22)) adopted by MEPC, the Code was extended to cover marine pollution aspects and applies to ships built after 1 July 1986.

\*\* This chapter applies to ships constructed on or after 1 January 1994.
