\* The purpose of this Code provides an international standards for the safe carriage by sea of liquefied gases (and other substances listed in the Code) in bulk. To minimize risks to the ships involved in such carriage, to their crews and to the environment, the Code prescribes the design and constructional standards of such ships and the equipment they should carry, and applies to ships built on or after 1 July 1986.
